




Livestock Population trend ,Gujarat (in Lakh)

Camel Population of Gujarat




-43% decline in Decade

Camel Breeding : Challenges?

- Due to Mechanization, decreasing demand for draft purpose
- Shrinking Grazing Resources due to restricted access in Forest area, rapid industrialization, and conversion of land for other purposes
- No formal investment in Market Development for Milk, Fiber and other products
- Policy neglect as Camel has never been considered in category of productive livestock



 Months


Milk Yield

- Inter-calving Period:
 - 18-24months
- Average Milk Yield 2.5
 litre to 6 Litre /day

Sale of Camel: only Source of Income

- Sale of Male Camel (Age of 1-2 years) @ price between Rs.10,000/-to Rs.15,000/-
- Male camel raised for breeding purpose can fetch higher price upto Rs. 25,000/-
- Rabaris have shifted to other livestock (Cattle, buffalo, sheep & Goat)
- Rabaris normally give their herd to Jats for grazing by paying Rs.100-150 per camel/pm
- Shifted Wage laborers/ Agriculture laborers (can earn Rs.10,000-15,000 per month)

Research on Camel Milk

- 4-5 times higher Vitamin C than cow milk (Gorakhmal & KML Pathak)
- 30-100 times as much lactoferrin as Cow milk (Yagil, 1985) helps in treatment of infectious disease and act as anti-viral, anti-fungal antiinflammatory anti-carcinogenic (EI-Agamy et al., 1992)
- High Mineral Content (Mal et al., 2007)

(Sodium, Potassium, Copper, Iron, Zinc, Magnasium)

- Low total Solids and Fat Content (Singh et al., 2006) (Agrawal et al., 2003)
- Self life is > 10 hrs in room temperature

Research on Camel Milk

- High unsaturated fatty acid and low saturated fatty acid than human milk
- Insulin-like Protein detected 52 count /litre.
 500ml camel milk everyday reduces need of insulin dose by 30% (Agrawal et al., 2002)
- High Concentration of 6 type volatile fatty acids (Linoleic acid and polyunsaturated fatty acid) is effective in improving skin tone and wrinkels
- Alpha hydroxy acids known to plump the skin and smoothes fine lines (NRCC, 2007)

Research on Camel Milk

- Camel milk is used for curing tuberculosis antidote for typhoid and toxicity, jaundice multiple sclerosis, psoriasis, ulcers, skin Cancers (Mal et al., 2000, 2001and 2006a)
- Controlling high Blood Pressure, food allergies, autisam, malaria, constipation (AI Jasim 2004, Shabo et al.,2005, Wernery 2006, Eyassu Seifu 2007)
- Contains wonder drugs containing enzymes with anti-bactarial and anti-viral properties.
- Camel milk for lactose intolerant people and food allergies



Proposed Infrastructure Plan :


- Camel Milk Processing and Packaging Plant at Kukma with capacity of 20KL/day

- 3 BMCs having capacity of 5-8KL each
- **Refrigerated Vehicles** to transport Camel Milk




10 Year Projection Plan for Camel Milk Availability from Kutch

Camel Milk Market in India Since 2015











Economic Impact Analysis



- The camel milk market has generated an economy worth Rs. 8-9 crore per annum in the region, an average monthly household income of Rs.28,000/- to Rs.30,000/-
- In 2022, twenty-two pastoralist youths have returned to herding, buying camels as an investment and recognizing camel herding as a remunerative livelihood option.
- **13.5 % increase** in the camel population in the district over the last ten years; it is the only part of the country where camel numbers are increasing.
- **80% of camel population** in the district is being covered under health camps organized by the State AH department in collaboration with KUUMS.




